*A new 18,800 square foot two story addition with basement to the existing historic Newberry Hall. The Kelsey Museum is internationally recognized for its collection of approximately 100,000 artifacts from Egypt and ancient Mediterranean civilizations. The addition will allow the museum to better store and display this collection.*



*The structure is a clean architecturally exposed reinforced concrete building designed to adhere to a finely detailed architectural program. Portions of the structure support a stone cladding which complements the stone construction of the historic original building.*

*The structure also required detailing to tie the new structure to the historic facility.*
